

## **Safety, Health & Environmental Management**

**Q.** What type of services will you be looking for over the next three years?

**A.** SHEM recently awarded a contract for occupation safety and health and environmental management support services. This contract has one base year and four option years. Assuming the contractor performs well, SHEM does not anticipate other contracting requirements during this time frame.

**Q.** Saw the Market Resource for the CSS Contact. Will there be any more? What are the criteria? Any interest in Recovery Plans?

**A.** It is highly unlikely that there will be other requests for services though we are interested in recovery plans. However, we have a current contracting vehicle for similar services. We have no plans to establish a new contract requirement for such services.

**Q.** What kinds of work do we get into, and do we have any contracts available?

**A.** SHEM provides occupation safety and health and environmental management services for Department of State overseas operations. SHEM has no current contracting requirements.

**Q.** Is 8(a) important to you?

**A.**Yes.

**Q.** Do you have IAQ program in place?

**A.** Yes. Facilities are designed, operated and maintained to avoid IAQ problems. When complaints possibly related to IAQ problems are reported, health and safety professionals from OM/SHEM investigate and, if needed devise solutions. The post or OM/FAC would typically implement the solutions.
